

CALL FOR POSTERS

ISCTE - University Institute of Lisbon invites you to participate in “The International Symposium INTOVIAN – Protecting children aged 0 to 3 from domestic violence”, which will be held in Lisbon, ISCTE-IUL, on the 21st and 22nd November 2014. This symposium aims to involve researchers and professionals in the community and participation is free.

This meeting marks the end of an international project that aimed to develop a screening protocol for infant and toddler abuse and neglect, to be applied during early mother-infant routine health exams, in six European countries. In addition, this project aims to influence public policies in the context of health, social services and protection system of children at risk, with the ultimate goal of promoting their physical and mental health.

To promote an inclusive and participatory reflection, we invite researchers and community professionals to present their research and/or intervention projects with children aged 0 to 5 years in different contexts in a poster format.

The posters may cover:

- Original works developed in the area of assessment and intervention for children at risk, from 0 to 5 years, and their respective contexts of development;
- Intervention programs implemented in institutions or in the community with children from 0 to 5 years;
- Other works of theoretical and/or practical relevance in the context of this meeting.

Those who are interested should submit an abstract with a maximum of 250 words and three keywords. Abstracts focused on research projects should be submitted in English, and abstracts of intervention projects can be submitted in English or Portuguese. The best poster will receive an award during the symposium.

Abstracts should be submitted until **15th October 2014** to the following email: intovian.symposium@gmail.com. After this deadline, applications will be evaluated and selected by the Scientific Committee, and the results will be communicated on 20th of October.
