What is the INTOVIAN Tool for?

To initially identify families either at risk of/or with already established infant and toddler abuse and neglect problems, by looking for risk indicators of infant/toddler abuse and neglect, or of abusive relationship patterns in **any** caregiverinfant/toddler dyad.

What is the Target Population of the Intovian Tool?

Infants and toddlers aged from 0 to 3 years.

Who can use the INTOVIAN Tool?

Health visitors, nurses, pediatricians, social workers, psychologists and child psychiatrists.

When and Where should the INTOVIAN Tool be Completed?

During the first intake or routine infant/toddler examination.

Child Abuse and Neglect: Facts

- Child abuse and neglect is a major public health problem.
- Infants and toddlers are at the greatest risk for maltreatment and homicide compared to older children.
- Early identification of, and intervention for, child abuse and neglect, can prevent or reduce long-term adverse effects for the child-victim.
- Domestic violence against infant/toddler is rarely detected or prevented before hospitalization.
- Screening for child abuse and neglect has been reported as inadequate.
